- *Girls ball used
- *2-20 minute 1/2's, running clock stops last 2 minutes of each half for dead balls. Five min. half-time.
- *Man to Man defense
- *No press

- *5 fouls per player, per game. Bonus=7 team fouls, double bonus=10 team fouls, Technical=2 pts. + possession of ball
- *2 time outs per half. Timeouts do not carryover from halftime
- *O.T.=3 minutes with 1 time out per team, second O.T. decided by free throws from each person on court at buzzer
- *Technical foul is automatic 2 pts and possession of the ball

- No protests, referee's decisions are final.
- Anyone yelling at referees or disputing of calls will be asked to leave.
