The Deerfield Community Center would like to invite teams to participate in our annual Deerfield Days Youth Baseball Tournament. There will be a 9 & 10 year old tourney and an 11 & 12 year old tourney. It will be held on July 12-14 at the Deerfield Community Park. Games on July 12 start in the afternoon. Rain date for the tournament will be July 19-21.

We will limit teams to **LEAGUE-ROSTER BASED** teams only. We are not allowing "all-star" or tournament teams into the tourney **unless approved by the tournament director.** If your team is found ineligible, you will forfeit your games and lose your fee. Depending on the number of teams in the tournament, this will either be a double-elimination tournament or a combination of pool and seeded bracket play. We will accept up to a total of 16 teams for this tournament.

We will use the official 2013 rules for the Eastern Suburban Youth Baseball League. Exception, pitchers may only pitch 2 consecutive innings per game for both leagues. In AL, there will be NO WALKS and we will use the "toss-up" rule as stated in the ESYBL rules. **We will only allow 9-10 year old and younger players in the 9-10 Division and 11-12 year old and younger players in the 11-12 Division. No over-age players.** Rules will be mailed or e-mailed to the coach or can be found at www.Esybl.org. Brackets will be communicated before the tourney.

Entry fee is \$125 per team if received before June 7, 2013. Please include \$150 after this date. Individual medals will be handed out to all participants. A team trophy will be presented to the 1st and 2nd place teams for each division.
