- **We would like to remind all teams, coaches, parents etc. that this is a learning experience** for the players and that the following will not be allowed:

 - No unsportsmanlike play or conduct by players, coaches, spectators.(will be dealt with accordingly)
- **Each team will need to provide one person to keep book or clock.**
- First team listed will be designated as home team.
- First place for pool play will be determined by over-all record within their pool. If there is a tie, we will look at head-to-head record, then the team with the fewest points given up.
- Individual medals will be awarded to players in the Championship game for 1st place and 2nd place.

RULES Boys Gr. 4

- *Girls ball used
- *2-20 minute 1/2's, running clock stops last 2 minutes of each half for dead balls. Five min. half-time.
- *Man to Man defense
- *No press (Except final minute of the game unless ahead by 12+ pts
- Free throw shooter may jump over line after shooting
- *5 fouls per player, per game. Bonus=7 team fouls, double bonus=10 team fouls, Technical=2 pts. + possession of ball
- *2 time outs per half. Timeouts do not carryover from halftime
- *O.T.=3 minutes with 1 time out per team, second O.T. decided by free throws from each person on court at buzzer. **Repeated until winner determined.**
