**Tournament Rules**

Location: **Deerfield High School**, 300 Simonson Blvd. Turn west off of Hwy. 73.  
or

**Deerfield Elementary School** - 340 W. Quarry

You **MUST** enter off Liberty St and enter in back door of school (north side). Take Hwy. 73 to downtown Deerfield. Turn west on Liberty St.(Bank of Deerfield-Downtown Branch at corner). Turn left on the last driveway before you head out of town (Jerdee Lane). This will be the only entrance that will be open.

Admission: Adults \$3.00 Students \$1.00 Children 4 and under are Free.

Concessions: A wide variety of food and beverages will be available.

**NO CARRY INS** allowed in the school.

- **Boys and Girls Gr. 4-5** \*Girls ball used
  - \*2-20 minute 1/2's, running clock stops last 2 minutes of each half for dead balls. Five min. half-time.
  - \*Man to Man defense
  - \*No press
  - Free throws-Player starts behind line and may jump over.
  - \*5 fouls per player, per game. Bonus=7 team fouls, double bonus=10 team fouls, Technical=2 pts. + possession of ball
  - \*2 time outs per half. Timeouts do not carryover from halftime
  - \*O.T.=3 minutes with 1 time out per team, second O.T. decided by free throws from each person on court at buzzer. Repeat through all players again if necessary, etc...
  - \*Technical foul is automatic 2 pts and possession of the ball
- **Each team will need to provide one person to keep book or clock.**

#### **Boys and Girls Gr. 6-8**

- \*Girls ball used (except for boys 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade will use regulation ball).
- \*2-20 minute 1/2's, running clock stops last 2 minutes of each half for dead balls. Five min. half-time.
- \*Any defense will be allowed
- \*Press anytime except if team is up by 12 points
- \*5 fouls per player, per game. Bonus=7 team fouls, double bonus=10 team fouls, Technical=2 pts. + possession of ball
- \*2 time outs per half. Timeouts do not carryover from halftime
- \*O.T.=3 minutes with 1 time out per team, second O.T. decided by free throws from each person on court at buzzer. Repeat through all players again if necessary, etc...
- \*Technical foul is automatic 2 pts and possession of the ball
- **Each team will need to provide one person to keep book or clock.**

**We would like to remind all teams, coaches, parents etc. that this is a learning experience** for the players and that the following will not be allowed:

- No protests, referee's decisions are final.
- Anyone yelling at referees or disputing of calls will be asked to leave.
