Deerfield Elementary School - 340 W. Quarry

You **MUST enter off Liberty St** and enter in back door of school (north side). Take Hwy. 73 to downtown Deerfield. Turn west on Liberty St.(Bank of Deerfield-Downtown Branch at corner). Turn left on the last driveway before you head out of town (Jerdee Lane). This will be the only entrance that will be open.

Admission: Adults \$3.00 Students \$1.00 Children 4 and under are Free.

Concessions: A wide variety of food and beverages will be available.

- **NO CARRY INS** will be allowed into the school.

We would like to remind all teams, coaches, parents etc. that this is a learning experience for the players and that the following will not be allowed:

- Protests of referee's calls - decisions are final.
- Spectator's consistently yelling at referees – will be asked to leave.
- Unsportsmanlike play or conduct by players, coaches, spectators
 - .(will be dealt with accordingly)

General Tournament Notes:

- **Each team will need to provide one person to keep book or clock.-This person becomes part of the officiating team and are asked to act accordingly.**
- First team listed will be designated as home team.

- First place for pool play will be determined by over-all record within their pool. If there is a tie, we will look at head-to-head record, then the team with the fewest points given up.
- Individual medals will be awarded to players in the Championship game for 1st place and 2nd place.

RULES-

- 7th /8th grade boys use regulation ball, all others us 28.5” ball
- 2-20 minute halves
- Running clock except in the last 2 minutes of each half
- Any defense will be allowed in 6th-8th grade, “man-to-man” only in 4th and 5th grade.
- Press allowed anytime for 6th-8th grade, except if team is up by 12 or more points
- No Press in 4th/5th grade except in final minute of game unless ahead by 12+ points.
- Free throw shooters may jump across the free throw line for 4th/5th grade only
- Bonus=7 team fouls, double bonus=10 team fouls
- Technical or Flagrant Foul = 2 pts. + possession of ball
- Intentional foul= 2 free throws + possession of ball
- 2 time outs per half
- O.T.=3 minutes with 1 time out per team, second O.T. decided by free throws from each person on court at buzzer. **Repeated until winner determined.**
- Only the head coach will be allowed to stand on the sidelines. Additional coaches must remain seated during games.
