The Deerfield Community Center would like to invite teams to participate in our annual Deerfield Days Youth Baseball Tournament. There will be a 9 & 10 year old tourney and an 11 & 12 year old tourney. It will be held on July 8-10 at the Deerfield Community Park. Games on July 8 start in the afternoon. Rain date for the tournament will be July 15-17.

We will limit teams to **LEAGUE-ROSTER BASED** teams only. We are not allowing “all-star” or tournament teams into the tourney **unless approved by the tournament director.** Depending on the number of teams in the tournament, this will either be a double-elimination tournament, a combination of pool and bracket play or round-robin. We will accept up to a total of 16 teams for this tournament.

We will use the official 2016 rules for the Eastern Suburban Youth Baseball League. Exception, pitchers may only pitch 2 consecutive innings per game for both leagues. **We will only allow 9-10 year old and younger players (players that just finished 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade) in the 9-10 Division and 11-12 year old (players that just finished 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade) and younger players in the 11-12 Division. No over-age players. NO CHROME HELMETS ALLOWED** Rules will be mailed or e-mailed to the coach or can be found at [www.Esybl.org](http://www.Esybl.org). Brackets will be communicated before the tourney.

Entry fee is \$125 per team if received before June 3, 2016. Please include \$150 after this date. Individual medals will be handed out to all participants. A team trophy will be presented to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place teams for each division.

Industrial Dr., Deerfield WI 53531**-On Hwy 73 just north of Deerfield’s downtown, turn east on Industrial Dr. South (D & J Service Center at the corner, ~50 yards south of the Glacial Drumlin Bike Trail).
