Deerfield Elementary School (DES)- 340 W. Quarry is official address-please note, must enter off Liberty/Jerdee Ln. You **MUST enter off Liberty St** and enter in back door of school (north side). Take Hwy. 73 to downtown Deerfield. Turn west on Liberty St.(Bank of Deerfield-Downtown Branch at corner). Turn left on the last driveway before you head out of town (Jerdee Lane). This will be the only entrance that will be open.
